

The Presencing Foundation Program

June 22 - 26, 2013 – Bali, Indonesia

The Presencing Foundation Program introduces the U-process and Theory U, a social technology for helping to bring about profound innovation and change. The focus of this method is on sensing and actualizing emerging future opportunities, both individually and collectively. In this program you will learn how to sense and seize future opportunities and how to connect to the deeper journey of your professional and personal life in order to become a more effective leader and change-maker in your work environment. We encourage participants to attend in teams.

In working with leadership teams across sectors and industries, Otto Scharmer realized that leaders could not meet their existing challenges by operating on the basis of past experience alone. A synthesis of his most recent research has resulted in a framework and practice called presencing, which he elaborates in Theory U: Leading from the Future as It Emerges (2007), and in Presence: An Exploration of Profound Change in People, Organizations, and Society (2005), co-authored with Peter Senge, Joseph Jaworski, and Betty Sue Flowers. With his colleagues, Scharmer has used presencing to facilitate profound innovation and change processes both within companies and across societal systems. Participants will learn and apply interdependent elements of the U-Process / Presencing:

- Four levels of responding to change
- Four types of listening and conversation
- Three (inner) instruments: Open Heart, Open Mind, Open Will
- Accessing and bringing forth one's authentic Self
- Overcoming three barriers in one's inner work
- Five movements of Presencing as a social technology for change (co-initiating, co-sensing, co-inspiring, co-creating, co-evolving)
- Twenty-four principles and practices of Presencing

Who Should Participate?

This four-day experiential workshop is for leaders and teams at all levels. It introduces a collective leadership methodology for sensing and facilitating profound innovation and change both within organizations and across societal systems.

A large portion of the workshop is dedicated to case clinics, where participants will apply what they are learning to challenges in their own work. Participants will benefit the most from this workshop by coming with a concrete project they are working on and/or by attending with one or more colleagues/stakeholders. If individuals work as a consultant or facilitator, we encourage them to participate with a client.

This workshop will be of particular value to teams in the early stages of working on joint projects. While developing individual and collective leadership capacities, participants will simultaneously create a shared vision for their projects, engage with internal and external stakeholders, and prototype new ideas.

Registration will be confirmed in accordance with a balanced mix of participants.

MARIAN GOODMAN is passionate about authentic leadership and profound systems change to build a healthy society that works for all. As a director of the Presencing Institute she works with Dr. Otto Scharmer on many initiatives, such as the “Global Wellbeing & GNH Lab”, guiding Learning Journeys (Brazil, Bhutan) in order to develop prototype innovations ‘Beyond GDP’. Marian facilitates Theory U Programs in South Africa, Brazil, Germany, and Asia.

FRANS SUGIARTA is the senior learning facilitator of United in Diversity Forum Indonesia and also a core team member of the Presencing Institute. Frans works with Otto Scharmer, Peter Senge and Ben Chan in facilitating a leadership program called IDEAS (Innovative Dynamic Education and Action for Sustainability) attended by influential leaders from Government, Business and Civil Society in Asia. Frans uses Theory U as the foundation of his consultancy work

in guiding transformation processes in companies and organizations. He is based in Jakarta, Indonesia.



DR. BEN CHAN is the Director of Education Academy at United in Diversity Forum (UID), Indonesia. He is the local faculty in the MIT-IDEAS Indonesia Program. Prior to his present position in UID, he was lecturing on Entrepreneurship and Business Creation at the Singapore Management University. Ben is also the Executive Director of Singapore’s Young Entrepreneurship Center, a human-capital center where young entrepreneurs come to learn the soft-skills of commercial and social entrepreneurship.



OTTO SCHARMER is a Senior Lecturer at MIT, the founding chair of the Presencing Institute, and a founding member of the MIT Green Hub. Scharmer introduced the theoretical framework and practice called “presencing” in his book Theory U: Leading from the Future as It Emerges (2007). With his colleagues, Scharmer has used presencing to facilitate profound innovation and change processes both within companies and across societal systems.
